COULD THE WIRING IN YOUR HOME BE UNSAFE?



If your property has not already been rewired within the last 25-30 years, the chances are it will need upgrading at least in part in order to bring it up to current standards.

Your houses age is the first sign that it may need rewiring

If your house was built prior to the late 1970s you should consider having an electrical safety inspection done. Older homes were not designed for today's multiple appliance and lighting loads, and contain either VIR (Vulcan Indianised Rubber) or TRS (Tough Rubber Sheath) wiring and porcelain re-wireable fuses. This wiring system has been found to perish and decay, leading to hazards including fires.

Other than age, further signs your house may need a rewire

Signs that you may need to rewire your home include electrical shocks from appliances, sockets, and switches; outlets and cords that get warm when in use; fuses that blow regularly and/or frequent power outages.

Wiring in older homes is unlikely to meet current NZ Electrical standards. Any homes containing the old wiring should be rewired with TPS (Tough Plastic Sheath) as soon as possible and have their fuses replaced with circuit breakers and residual current devices.

How old wiring can affect your home
Not only is old wiring a safety hazard it can
also affect the sale of your home should you
want to sell it in the future. Home buyers,
some mortgage lenders and insurance
companies want to know that the home
wiring is safe and adequate for the demands of
modern living. Insurers may decline insurance
cover on the home and lenders are reluctant
to lend money without the house being
rewired.

How much does it cost to rewire a house? The cost to rewiring your home will depend on a number of factors. Not just the size of the house and number of electrical cables and fittings but also the accessibility through the sub-floor and ceiling areas and the extent of rewiring that is required.
